### Travel & iPad/Tablet/Slate/Surface

I often get asked “should I take my iPad (tablet, slate or surface) away with me on holidays?” My answer is always a definite yes.

The things you will use it for include:

- Connect using free WiFi to pick up eMails and news of home, or to send pictures to friends.
- Research places you are going to, like history or maps.
- Keep up-to-date with news from anywhere.
- Book travel and accommodation for the next leg of your trip.
- Copy photos from your camera to your Tablet to hold a backup copy.
- Use the camera on the Tablet.
- Save photos to cloud storage.
- Update your FaceBook and social media with places, activities and photos.
- Internet Phone & Video calls.
- Carry offline maps with you.
- Play games or read books while waiting for your plane or during travel.
- Alarm clock for wake up calls and world time in multiple countries..
- Listen to your music.
- You can connect to your office computer.
- Carry photos from home to show the people you are visiting.
- Recording written or audio notes about your travel or things to do on your return.

Now some words of warning:

Your device is an easy target for theft. It is also delicate – so pack it safely. And lastly, charges can very expensive overseas, so either turn off Data Roaming or purchase a pre-paid, local area SIM card when you arrive at your destination.
