### Send a Digital Parcel

We know that eMails are a cheap and easy method of sharing photos and files. Particularly if you want to get photos on or off your iPad/Tablet/Phone etc.

But what if you have more mail to send than will fit in an envelope, this is when you need to send a “digital parcel”. We’ve talked about cloud storage previously like dropbox, one drive, google drive, and more, but these clouds are also very useful for sending bulk quantities of files, like a whole folder of photos.

Simply upload the particular folder of photos to your chosen cloud, then share that folder with whoever you want. Now that you have shared this folder, your friend can view or download copies of the photos. And with your permission, they can also add photos to your folder. This copy in the cloud is also a great backup copy if something should happen to your mobile device.
